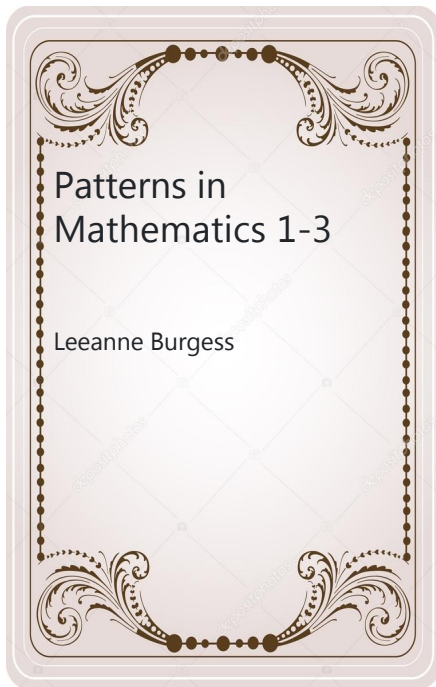


Patterns in Mathematics 1-3
